



The ParkPass exempts you from paying the daily \$5 parking fee at state parks, and the Historic Sites Family Pass exempts up to 4 visitors from admission fees to state historic sites.

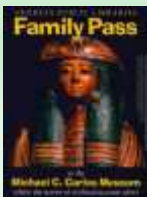
Check out the Chehaw Park Pass and present it along with your checkout receipt at the Chehaw admissions gate within 7 days. One pass is good for free admission to the park and zoo for up to 2 adults and 4 children ages 4 – 18; admission for children under 4 is free. The pass may not be used for special events.

Adults with a valid library card from any branch of a participating public library system throughout the state of Georgia* may access the Zoo Atlanta Library Pass. One pass is available for checkout at each participating branch and may be checked out once per year, per household.
